Entries

- Entries may close early if it is expected that we will exceed the time for the pool booking.
- Individual entries close 11:59pm Monday 1 June 2026*
* If not closed prior due to the number of entries and estimated timeline.
- Relay team entries close Thursday 4 June 2026.
- Discuss relays with your teammates/ team captain. Your team captain will submit relay entries through Swim Central.
- Late changes to entered relays can be made up to 2 hours before the race.
- Entries from swimmers registered with overseas Masters Swimming associations are welcome. International entrants should contact the Administrator.

Important meet information

- Maximum of 6 individual swims per person per day.
- Maximum of 3 Relay swims per person per day.
- No offline entries or payments are available.
- If there is a mistake or an event missing, contact the MSV Administrator.
- All swimmers must be financial and active Masters Swimming Australia members at date of entry to the meet.



- Masters swimmer ages will be calculated as at 31st December 2026.
- To be eligible to swim in a relay, a swimmer must have entered at least one individual event.
- There is no limit on the number of teams that a club may enter in any age group. However, only the A team may score points.
- All members of a relay team must be members of the same club.
- This competition will be governed by the Rules of Masters Swimming Australia at the close of entries. These can be found on the MSA website.
- Visiting interstate and international teams are welcome and are eligible for awards.
- Visitors must show a proof of registration with an equivalent masters swimming association overseas. No guest swimmers.
- The final program will be available up to 2 days prior to the event.
- Times and records are provisional until finalised.
- The pool survey has been certified.
- In order to allow meet officials a break from activities on and around the pool deck, a formal break in the program of events may be called. The time will be decided on the day of the meet and will depend on the number of swimmers entered in each event and the program.
- This meet will include Multi-Class swimmers. More information about Multi-Class can be found on the MSV website.

Timekeeping

Clubs are requested to bring stopwatches and prepare a roster as all swimmers are expected to assist with timekeeping.

Awards

Medals will be awarded to first placegetters in individual events. Ribbons will be awarded to second and third placegetters in individual events and for first, second, and third placegetters in relays.
