ENTRIES:

- Individual entries OPEN: 8 January 2026. CLOSE 10:00pm Friday 3 April 2026.
- Online Relay TEAM entry opens Saturday 4 April 2026.
- Online Relay Team entries CLOSE 4:00 pm Monday 6 April 2026.
- Your Team Captain will submit relay entries.
- Late changes to entered relays can be made up to 2 hours before the race.
- All event entries must be submitted with a time (estimated is okay).
- Entries from swimmers registered with overseas Masters Swimming associations are welcome. International entrants should contact recorder@mastersswimmingvic.org.au to register.

TIMEKEEPING:

Clubs are requested to bring stopwatches and prepare a roster as ALL swimmers are expected to assist with timekeeping. There will be a Club / Lane roster published with the program.

IMPORTANT MEET INFORMATION:

- This event will be dual sanctioned with Swimming Victoria.
- Maximum of 8 individual swims per person per day.
- Maximum of 2 Relay swims per person per day.
- Individual entries close 3 April 2026 at 10:00 pm.
- Relay entries close 6 April 2026 at 4:00 pm.
- ALL online payments will be charged by "MASTERSSWIMMINGVIC"
- No offline entries or payments are available.

- All swimmers must be current 2026 financial and active Masters Swimming Australia members at the date of entry to the Meet.
- All Masters swimmers who enter the meet need to renew for 2026 before entering the competition.
- Masters Swimmer ages will be calculated as at 31st December 2026.
- To be eligible to swim in a relay, a swimmer must have entered at least one individual event.
- There is no limit on the number of teams that a club may enter in any age group. All teams may score points.
- All members of a Relay team MUST be members of the same club.
- **This competition will be governed by the Rules of Masters Swimming Australia (which can be found at [Rules and Policies | Masters Swimming](#)) and Swimming Australia (Swimming Australia Members) as of the close of entries.**
- Visiting interstate and international teams are welcome and are eligible for awards.
- First place medals will be awarded to place getters. Second, and Third place getters will receive ribbons.
- Visitors must show a proof of registration with an equivalent body overseas. No guest swimmers.
- Final program will be available 2 days prior to the event.

Please note: Times and Records are Provisional until finalised. The Pool Survey has been Certified.

Please note that in order to allow Meet Officials a break from activities on and around the pool deck, a formal break in the program of events may be called. When this will be, will be decided upon the day of the Meet and will depend on numbers of swimmers entered in each event.

This Meet will include Multi-Class swimmers. This is a MSV initiative to provide swimmers with disabilities an opportunity to compete in a State competition. More information about Multi-Class can be found at [Multi Class | Masters Swimming Victoria](#).

Individual Swimmer Registration

During the first phase of online meet registration, January 8 – April 3, individual Masters swimmers shall sign up on the **Club Assist website**

(Swimming Australia members will register through Swim Central).



Relay Registration

During the second phase of online meet registration, April 4 – April 6, Masters coaches and relay captains shall build relays on Club Assistant software with the swimmers in the online meet entry roster, and pay a \$10 per relay fee.

Please Check:

- You have registered your membership details properly in Swim Central.
- You have **not** used Autofill (please manually type data like name, dob, etc).
- Make sure that you have registered / renewed your 2026 MSA membership - **at LEAST** 2 days before entering.
- Please make sure you are consistent with your name and entries as in Swim Central, e.g. Robert not Bob, or Kate not Catherine, or Tony not Anthony etc.
