#### Cost

Registration \$60 (includes swims)

#### Time

Warm up is available from 9am – 9:45am

Races start at 10am and are expected to finish around 4pm

#### Entries

- Maximum of 2 individual swims.
- Entries may close early if it is expected that we will exceed the time for the pool booking.
- Individual entries close **Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July 11:59pm\***
- \*If not closed prior due to the number of entries and estimated timeline.
- Entries from swimmers registered with overseas Masters Swimming associations are welcome. International entrants should contact the MSV Administrator.

#### Important meet information

- Heats will be swum slowest to fastest. Events may be combined if necessary. Strokes will be swum as 1 person per lane.
- It is highly encouraged that you bring a timekeeper and lap counter to help with your swim and that you help other swimmers as well.
- The final program will be available up to 2 days prior to the event.
- Times and records are provisional until finalised.
- The pool survey has been certified.
- In order to allow meet officials a break from activities on and around the pool deck, a formal break in the program of events may be called. The time will be decided on the day of the meet and will depend on the number of swimmers entered in each event.
- This meet will include Multi-Class swimmers. More information about Multi-Class can be found on the MSV website.



- All Australian entrants must be financial and active members of Masters Swimming Australia to enter the meet.
- Visiting interstate and international swimmers are welcome and are eligible for awards. Visitors must show a proof of registration with an equivalent masters swimming association overseas. No guest swimmers.
- The competition is governed by the Rules of MSA as at the close of entries. These can be found on the MSA website.
- Age is as of 31 December 2026.
- Ribbons only will be awarded to placegetters.
- Lanes will be set aside throughout the day for warm up and cool down.
