Entries

- The meet is to be dual sanctioned with Swimming Victoria.
- All MSV members, and SV members aged 18+, are invited to participate.
- Up to 7 swims per entrant.
- Entries may close early if it is expected that we will exceed the time for the pool booking.
- Individual entries close **Sunday 2nd August 11:59pm***
- *If not closed prior due to the number of entries and estimated timeline.
- Entries from swimmers registered with overseas Masters Swimming associations are welcome. International entrants should contact the MSV Administrator.

Important meet information

- The meet is not a state championship and no medals or ribbons will be awarded.
- The pool has been surveyed. Results will be recognised on Swim Central and, for masters, the MSA Results Portal.
- Heats will be swum slowest to fastest. Events may be combined if necessary. Strokes will be swum as 1 person per lane.
- The final program will be available up to 2 days prior to the event.
- Times and records are provisional until finalised.
- This meet will include Multi-Class swimmers. More information about Multi-Class can be found on the MSV website.
- All Australian entrants must be financial and active members of Masters Swimming Australia to enter the meet.



- Visiting interstate and international swimmers are welcome. Visitors must show proof of registration with an equivalent masters swimming association overseas. No guest swimmers.
- The competition is governed by the Rules of Masters Swimming Australia and Swimming Australia at the close of entries. Masters Swimming Australia competition rules apply to masters swimmers. Swimming Australia competition rules apply to Swimming Australia swimmers.
- Masters age is as of 31 December 2026.
