- 3. Trifles are to be delivered to the registration desk.

- 5. Entries may be photographed and the competitor's name used for the purposes of Glamourhead Sharks publicity.
- 6. All entries will be consumed at the completion of the contest.

- 7. A complete list of the ingredients of each entry must be supplied for the information of the judges, and club patrons, with the competition entry name.
- 8. The Glamourhead Sharks Aquatics Club is not responsible for any ingredients, or their effect on consumers, of the entry. A reasonable amount of alcohol is permitted. No other intoxicating substance is allowed.
- 9. The Glamourheads Aquatics Club is not responsible for any entry that causes offence. Entries with inappropriate themes may be excluded from the competition at the discretion of the judges.
- 10. Entries will be judged on appearance, taste and other factors at the judges' discretion.
- 11. Entries must be large enough to yield more than two serves for the benefit of judging.
- 12. Entries MUST be the work of the Swimmer and/or the Swimmer's family who is attending the Meet. [Swimmer, volunteer, official or spectator.]
